Effective May 11, 2009, the United States Postal Service® will be changing their rates. Enclosed with this letter you will find the rate module, which when installed, will update your WJS5, WJS10 or WJS20 scale to provide you with the latest supported USPS rates.

Installing the new rates is a simple process that should take less than five minutes. Before installing the new rates, review the enclosed installation instructions (steps 1 – 8). After the new rate module is installed, please return the old rate module in the prepaid, self-addressed padded envelope that arrived with this letter (step 9).

Please Note: It is the sole responsibility of the customer to install and verify that the rates are properly installed. Hasler will not be liable for rates that were not verified or installed properly.

WJS5, WJS10, WJS20 Scale - Rate Pak Installation Procedure: USPS May 2009

Step	Action	Figure
1	<p>Turn the scale's power switch, located at the back of the scale, to the OFF position.</p> <p>Note: If the rate module is removed from the scale or installed with the power on, severe damage may occur to the scale.</p>	
2	<p>Remove the scale platter.</p>	
3	<p>Remove the rate module cover from the top of the scale.</p>	
4	<p>Remove the rate module from the scale.</p>	
5	<p>Insert the new rate module. The rate module is designed to fit in only one direction. Rate module software version: H.08.032</p>	
6	<p>Re-attach the rate module cover.</p>	
7	<p>Re-attach the platter.</p> <p>Note: Verify that the platter's curved edging faces forward as shown.</p>	
8	<p>The new rates have been successfully loaded. Turn the scale's power switch to the ON position.</p>	
9	<p>After the new rate module is installed, please return the old rate module in the prepaid, self-addressed padded envelope.</p>
